Our goal was to provide a vehicle that would enhance communication within the organization and provide a resource of information to be used by our membership and other interested parties. We also look at the site as a means of marketing OHC to the general public.

What we have accomplished since November 2008 –

We updated the look of the Home page to a Headline format. This puts more information on the screen and helps to make it easier for a viewer to find the latest updates. We also moved the navigation from the bottom of the page to the side on all the main pages which should make moving around the site easier.

We updated the OHC merchandise page to include all the new logo items now available. Thanks to Cheryl Zielinski for putting the information together.

We have kept the Calendar, Officers and Committee chairs up to date. We maintained sign up sheets for the Equine Affaire booth and the All American Youth Show. We also kept the County Chapter information up to date. This past year we lacked info from only 2 counties.
