

Holmes County Bridle Trails

Holmes County Rails-to-Trails, www.holmestrail.org

PHASE 1: Holmesville to Millersburg

Location: County Road 189 in Holmesville to Wal-Mart (south end of Millersburg)

Current Status: Closed for construction

Length: 6.67 Miles

Current Surface: Paved

Future development: *9ft paved surface for biking, roller-blading, walking, running, and wheelchairs, with an adjoining 7ft chip and seal surface for horse-drawn vehicles and horseback riding*

Future Development: *This section is scheduled for construction during 2004.*

PHASE 2: Millersburg to Killbuck

Location: Wal-Mart (south end of Millersburg) to Railroad Depot in Killbuck

Current Status: Open

Length: 4.72 Miles

Current Surface: Primitive Earthen Trail (Rough and Rocky)

Future development: *Finely-packed crushed limestone surface for multi-purpose use*

PHASE 3: Killbuck to Glenmont

Location: A section of this trail will utilize County and Township Roads. Railroad Depot in Killbuck to State Route 60; to Township Road 65; To Township Road 64; To Township Road 54 and back onto trail at State Route 520

Current Status: **CLOSED**

Length: 3.85 Miles

Future development: *Finely-packed crushed limestone surface for multi-purpose use*

PHASE 4: Fredericksburg to Holmesville

Location: Holmes-Wayne County Line to County Road 192 in Holmesville

Current Status: Closed

Length: 3.45 Miles

Future development: *9ft paved surface for biking, roller-blading, walking, running, and wheelchairs, with an adjoining 7ft chip and seal surface for horse-drawn vehicles and horseback riding. This section is scheduled for construction during 2004.*

PHASE 5: Glenmont to Brinkhaven

Location: County Road 25 in Glenmont to Holmes-Knox County Line in Brinkhaven

Current Status: Open

Length: 7.47 Miles

Current Surface: Primitive Earthen and Cinder Trail

Future development: *Finely-packed crushed limestone surface for multi-purpose use*
